PRESS RELEASE

This afternoon I filed a District Attorney's Information with the Coos County Circuit Court charging Gabriel Christian Morris, DOB 09/22/1976 with two counts of Aggravated Murder. A warrant was issued for the arrest of Gabriel Morris with security being set at \$5,000,000.

Both bodies have now been positively identified. The female is identified as Robin Lynn Anstey, age 62. She is the biological mother of Mr. Morris and is believed to have been living at the Highway 42 South address. The male victim has been identified as Robert William Kennelly Jr., age 48. Mr. Kennelly was a resident at the Highway 42 South address. Ms. Anstey was his live in significant other. The truck that was found abandoned in the City of Coquille was registered to Mr. Kennelly.

The autopsies for both victims will be Saturday. Once I have the definitive cause of death I will release that information.

Aggravated Murder is punishable by the following possible sentences:

1. Death;
2. Life in prison without the possibility of parole; or

3. Life in prison with the possibility of parole after serving 30 years.

In addition, I have attached a more recent family photograph of the Morris family. I am told that the child is a bit older than portrayed in the picture.

In regards to the press release yesterday there are a couple of clarifications I would like to make. First of all, as noted above, Mr. Morris's full name is Gabriel Christian Morris with a DOB of 09/22/1976.

We believe based upon our review of the scene that the homicides occurred sometime between 7:30 PM and 9:30 PM on Monday, February 8, 2010. Gabriel Morris, Jessica Morris and their child were last seen in the silver Ford Taurus on Monday February 8, 2010 at approximately 9:30 PM.

Some have questioned whether the bodies were found in the truck that was located in Coquille or at the Highway 42 South residence. The bodies were located at the residence and not the truck.

We have determined that either Gabriel or Jessica Morris have family, friends or acquaintances in the Portland/Salem areas of Oregon, Idaho, Utah, Seattle, Washington and San Diego, California. We have no indication whether they have remained in the area or if they have fled the state.

To repeat what was said yesterday, Gabriel Morris is to be considered armed and dangerous. If he, Jessica Morris, their child or the automobile is located, citizens are strongly cautioned that they should not approach them or the car and should immediately call 911.
