PRESS RELEASE

This afternoon a material witness warrant was issued for Jessica Marie Morris, who is the wife of murder suspect Gabriel Christian Morris. Security on the warrant was set at \$1,000,000.

In addition, I have attached a more recent photo of Kalea Morris. Kalea is further described as being born in November of 2005 and is 3 foot, 6 inches in height, weighs 40 pounds, and has blond hair and blue eyes.

As of this time, we have not been able to locate Gabriel Morris, Jessica Morris or Kalea. We have not located the Silver Ford Taurus they were last seen driving. We assume at this time that they are still using the same vehicle.

Our investigative team has been expanded to include not only officers from local police agencies, but also to include additional support from the Oregon State Police. We have detectives from the Central Point Office, Roseburg Office and the Coos Bay Office participating. The Oregon State Police Crime Lab team from the Springfield Laboratory spent Wednesday and Thursday processing the residence where the murders occurred. A second Oregon State Police Crime Lab team from the Springfield Laboratory came to Coos County today to process

the abandoned pickup truck belonging to Mr. Kennelly and to also process a vehicle associated with the Morris family that they left behind when they fled on Monday. The State Police has also sent an analyst from their Salem office to assist in collating the information and tips coming in as the investigation continues. They have also sent two crime scene reconstruction experts to develop diagrams and recreations. One of the experts came from Roseburg; the other from Salem. I sincerely appreciate the tremendous support we have received from the Oregon State Police.

The Oregon Department of Justice has also provided an investigator from Salem to help with this investigation.

Once again, Gabriel Morris must be considered armed and dangerous. Anyone who sees these individuals should not attempt to contact them but should contact the police immediately by calling 911.
