



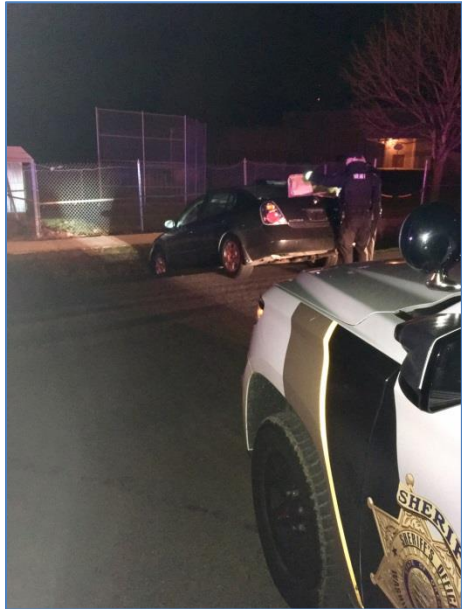

### Deputies Pursue Vehicle Related to Camas Crime Spree

February 14, 2017 – Washington County Sheriff's Office deputies pursued a stolen vehicle related to multiple burglaries in Camas.



On February 13, 2017, just before 11pm, a patrol deputy tried to stop a speeding vehicle near SW Canyon Road x SW Walker Road. The vehicle eluded the deputy. Other deputies came into the area to search for the car.

At 11:15pm, a deputy located the vehicle in a ditch near Cedar Park Middle School. No one was inside. A sheriff's office canine team was used to search for the suspect, but the suspect was not located.

Deputies learned that the car, a black 2002 Nissan Altima, had been reported stolen in Vancouver, Washington, on February 6<sup>th</sup>. During a search of the car, deputies located a

cash register believed to be from the Liberty Theatre in Camas, as well as items from other locations in Vancouver and Camas. They contacted the Camas Police Department and learned about several recent burglaries in Camas.
