Beaverton Police Department Victim Advocates are trauma-informed volunteers who are specially trained to respond on-scene along with officers/detectives to offer support to victims of crime who have experienced trauma. This is primarily domestic violence crimes, but could be any crime except sexual assaults. Our Victim Advocates provide 24 hour coverage, including holidays, offering emotional support, helping victims understand the criminal justice process, and explaining community resources that are available.
