Annie Wright Schools Open New Turf Field

Tacoma, Wash. – In a ceremony this Friday, May 19, 5:00-6:30 pm, Annie Wright Schools will officially open their new all-weather field.

Construction on the \$3 million James Memorial Field began last fall, replacing the original field built in 1923 with a high school regulation-sized synthetic turf field.

“The new field will serve as a wonderful space for both athletics and play,” said Head of Schools Christian G. Sullivan. “The project addresses our Board of Trustees’ strategic priority to develop a robust athletics program as well as provide a safe and beautiful space for kids to play, practice and compete year-round.”

The ceremony will honor donors to Annie Wright’s *From Strength to Strength* campaign, which raised capital for athletic facilities and the school’s endowment.

Founded in Tacoma, Washington, in 1884, Annie Wright Schools serve students from age three through high school. Annie Wright Lower and Middle Schools offer co-ed programs in Preschool through Grade 8, while separate Upper Schools for boys, starting in Fall 2017, and girls offer day and boarding options in Grades 9 through 12.
