Oregon Banner Tour, Doolittle Tokyo Raiders

To celebrate, honor and be inspired by courage of the WWII Army Air Corp, the faces of Doolittle Raiders will be touring the state of Oregon. 75 years ago, these brave men (79 of 80 trained in Pendleton) flew a one-way mission to bomb Tokyo—April 18, 1942. This Wall of Honor represents their values and embodies the courage of the entire WWII Generation—their contribution to our freedom and sacrifice of country.
