What types of documents should I shred?

The general rule is anything with the following information should be shred: **account numbers, birth dates, maiden names, passwords, signatures and Social Security numbers.**

- financial statements
- invoices
- personal documents
- medical/dental records
- pay stubs
- tax records
- employment records
- leases, contracts and letters
- pre-approved credit card applications
- utility bills
- investment documents
- credit reports
- documents containing passwords
- vehicle records

Please **do not** bring receipts, junk mail, magazines & catalogs, office paper, flyers/brochures or coupons.

Limit: 2 bankers boxes per person
