Cornelius Bank Robbed by Unknown Suspect

January 8, 2019

On Tuesday, January 8, 2019, at 6:02 p.m., Washington County Sheriff's Office deputies serving the City of Cornelius responded to a robbery at U.S. Bank, located at 1735 North Adair Street.

Witnesses reported that an unknown male approached the counter and passed a note to a teller demanding money. The suspect then fled the bank with an undisclosed amount of cash.

Deputies, along with a sheriff's office K-9 team and Forest Grove Police officers, conducted an extensive search of the area but the suspect was not located. No injuries were reported.



The suspect is described as a 20 to 30-year-old white male, medium build, brown beard, wearing prescription glasses and a light blue hooded sweatshirt with a stripe across the chest.

Security footage of the incident is not available for release at this time.

Deputies were assisted at the scene by [Forensic Science Unit](#) personnel. The Federal Bureau of Investigation was notified of the incident.
