Document outlines NCSD's 2019-2020 legislative objectives

Milwaukie, OR (January 25, 2019)—During the January 24, 2019 school board meeting, North Clackamas School District's Board of Directors adopted the 2019-2020 [legislative agenda](#). Developed following a series of collaborative work sessions involving community members, parents/guardians, students, legislators, and staff, the document identifies the priorities North Clackamas Schools (NCSD) believes will meaningfully contribute to its ability to realize the goals outlined in its [Strategic Direction](#).

In addition to articulating NCSD's perspective on the desired level of state funding, and the need for local control, the legislative agenda also identifies four key program areas where NCSD would like to see resources prioritized:

- Drop-Out Prevention and College/Career Readiness
- Social Services and Safe Learning Environments
- Early Learning
- Educator Recruitment and Retention

NCSD's [Parent Community Leadership Alliance](#) will be instrumental in advancing this agenda with elected officials, and the district hopes the document will assist the Oregon Legislature in meeting the state's needs for K-12 public education.
