Bond Information Community Forums

The Wapato School District is inviting Wapato community members to attend an upcoming public forum to learn about the District's school construction bond proposal that will appear on the February 13, 2024 election ballot.

If voters approve the \$33-million bond proposal, the money will be used to replace three aging schools in the District. Satus Elementary and Camas Elementary are each more than 70-years old. If the bond passes they would be replaced with a **SINGLE**, safer, larger elementary school building. The bond money would also be used to replace PACE High School, complete with a gym and space for enhanced career readiness programs. The PACE High School building is nearing 100-years old

This informational forum will help the community learn more about why the District is coming forward at this time with a bond proposal. Those who attend will also get a first-hand look at Camas Elementary School, which is one of the buildings that is slated to be replaced. They will also get an opportunity to see conceptual design plans for the new schools and where those schools could be built.

The District is hoping the community will take advantage of this opportunity to become more informed about the bond proposal and get their questions answered so they can make the most informed decision possible when casting their vote.
