His writing has appeared in *The New York Times Magazine*, *The New Yorker*, *McSweeney's Quarterly*, and *The San Francisco Chronicle*, among other outlets. From 2013-2019, he hosted and produced *The Organist*, an arts and culture podcast, for KCRW; he has also produced pieces for Radiolab and 99 Percent Invisible. He has been an editor at *The Believer* since 2003. He lives in western Massachusetts with his wife and son.
