A24-18784 – MISSING PERSON / SILVER ALERT

AUGUST 29, 2024

On August 29, 2024, the Cowlitz County Sheriff's Office received a report of a missing Longview resident. 69-year-old David F. Carey, who suffers from cognitive issues due to a traumatic brain injury, was last seen at 0930 hours at his Longview residence. He is believed to be driving a silver Hyundai Sonata sedan, Washington license BOB5238. Mr. Carey is described as being 5'-8" tall, 130 pounds, with blue eyes and gray hair. He was last seen wearing a multi-colored flannel shirt and blue jeans.

The Cowlitz County Sheriff's Office has requested a Silver Alert, to be issued through the Washington State Patrol. A picture of Mr. Carey and a stock photo of the vehicle are attached to this press release.

The Sheriff's Office requests anyone who has seen Mr. Carey, or the involved vehicle call 911.
