Interstate Communication of a Threat to Injure the Person of Another

REMARKS

Weatherhead is a transient who has ties to the Eugene, Oregon, and Reno, Nevada, areas. He has made violent threats against law enforcement and is known to carry a switch-blade knife. He is believed to be a user of illegal narcotics.

CAUTION

Shawn Fredrick Weatherhead is wanted for allegedly making threats against law enforcement agencies and personnel. Weatherhead has allegedly contacted the FBI's Public Access Line (PAL) in Clarksburg, West Virginia, or other FBI Offices around the country, approximately 1,000 times since December of 2015, from locations in Oregon and Nevada. On at least three occasions, between April 1 and April 2, 2017, Weatherhead allegedly threatened to kill people during his calls. On October 24, 2017, a federal arrest warrant was issued in the United States District Court, Northern District of California, Eureka, California, after Weatherhead was charged with interstate communication of a threat to injure the person of another.
