

Timeline

September 11, 2019

19-8844

On 9/11/19 Tiffany Hill reported her husband pushed her into a wall and tried to prevent her from calling 911. Keland Hill was arrested by the Clark County Sheriff's Office (CCSO) for Domestic Violence Assault IV (RCW 9A.36.041) and interfering with the reporting of domestic violence (RCW 9A.36.150). Keland Hill is booked into CCSO Jail. Later, on 11/13/19 after receiving medical information the assault charge is upgraded to Domestic Violence Felony Assault II (RCW 9A.36.021)

September 12, 2019

9-12-19 the initial Domestic Violence No-Contact Order (Order number 9z0911910) is served on Keland Hill related to the 9-11-19 assault. The order is later amended several times in the following months. Keland is released from jail on bail.

September 14, 2019

VPD 19-15237

Tiffany Hill reports to the Vancouver Police Department (VPD) that Keland Hill was asking about coaching their child at the bowling alley and if Tiffany was going to be present. The incident is investigated as a possible violation of the Domestic Violence No-Contact Order. VPD forwards case to the Clark County Domestic Violence Prosecutor for review.

September 19, 2019

CCSO 19-9104

On 9/19/19 Tiffany Hill Reported receiving a FaceTime call that she ignored from Keland Hill in violation of a Domestic Violence No-Contact Order. CCSO contacts Keland who claims it was an accident and that he canceled the call before it went through. CCSO forwards case to the Clark County Domestic Violence Prosecutor for review and consideration of charges.

October 6, 2019

CCSO 19-10438

On 10/6/2019 Keland Hill attempted to purchase a rifle at Walmart in Multnomah County, OR but was denied during the background check due to the domestic violence protection order in place. Multnomah County Sheriff took an initial report and forwards case to CCSO. CCSO conducts an investigation and charges are forwarded to the Clark County Domestic Violence Prosecutor against Keland Hill for attempting to possess a firearm (9.41.040.2A) and additional charges for violating a Domestic Violence No-Contact Order (RCW 26.50.110). Keland Hill was arrested on 11-7-19 by CCSO for these charges.

October 10, 2019

CCSO 19-9806

Keland Hill violated the Domestic Violence No-Contact Order (RCW 26.50.110) at the Peach Tree Restaurant while Tiffany Hill was there. Responding CCSO Deputies were unable to locate Keland Hill and he was believed to be living out of his car. Keland Hill was later arrested on 11-7-19 by CCSO for these charges.

November 7, 2019

CCSO 19-10758

Tiffany Hill reported seeing Keland Hill at several locations including a Thai restaurant at 13510 NE 82nd Street. CCSO Deputies locate a GPS tracker on Tiffany Hill's vehicle. Keland is arrested for Stalking (9A.46.110.5B) and violating a Domestic Violence No-Contact Order (RCW 26.50.110). Keland's two cell phones and Buick sedan are seized as evidence. Keland is booked into CCSO Jail. Keland Hill is also arrested for several pending charges from other cases (CCSO 19-9806 & CCSO 19-10438).

November 8, 2019

VPD 19-18549

Tiffany Hill comes to the Domestic Violence Prosecution Center to report receiving additional text messages from Keland Hill in violation of the Domestic Violence No-Contact Order. A Vancouver Police Department (VPD) Detective documents the violations and completes a danger assessment with Tiffany. The high Danger Assessment score placed Tiffany in the extreme risk category. The VPD detective added additional charges for violating a Domestic Violence No-Contact Order (RCW 26.50.110) to Keland Hill who is already in CCSO jail from previous arrests.

November 13, 2019

On 11/13/19 after receiving additional medical information the original assault charge (CCSO 19-8844) is upgraded to Domestic Violence Felony Assault II (RCW 9A.36.021). Clark County Domestic Violence Prosecutor's Office requests raising bail from \$75,000 to \$2,000,000 due to Danger Assessment showing victim is at extreme risk of being killed by the defendant. Keland Hill's bail is raised to \$250,000.

November 21, 2019

Keland Hill is released from CCSO Jail on \$250,000 bail.

November 26, 2019

CCSO 19-11370

Keland Hill shoots Tiffany Hill and her mother while they are parked at the Sarah J Anderson Elementary School. CCSO Deputies locate Keland Hill who shoots himself when confronted.
