For the week of May 3rd, 2021, Yamhill County as a whole is expected to receive 2,500 first doses of vaccine.

Please see breakdown of distribution below:

- Directly to YCPH: 2,100
- Pharmacy State allocation: 100
- Pharmacy Federal allocation: 1500

170 doses that are sent directly to YCPH will be pushed to primary care providers.

As of April 28th, 40,650 people in Yamhill County have received at least one dose of vaccine. This represents 47% of the total population age 16 or older.

Yamhill County is dedicated to do everything possible to ensure access for all people in Yamhill County who want to be vaccinated. Yamhill County continues to partner with organizations to provide mobile vaccine opportunities at places of employment. We are also increasing walk-in access with pop up events throughout the community. Event dates, times and locations can be found on our Yamhill County COVID-19 vaccine website. Yamhill County continues to use the Get Vaccinated Oregon (GVO) tool which can be found [here](#) for our vaccine registration process. This tool allows individuals to register, signs them up to receive important vaccine updates, helps to create an account and find a vaccination

provider, alerts individuals and gives instructions on how to schedule. People who are already registered with the Oregon GVO tool do not need to register again.
