The **Drug Enforcement Administration's (DEA) Take Back Day** event provides an opportunity for Americans to prevent drug addiction and overdose deaths by disposing of unused or expired prescription drugs.

ALLOWED: All unused and expired over the counter and prescription medications (solid or liquid) in consumer containers. Vape products (battery **MUST** be removed).



NOT ALLOWED: Intravenous solutions, injectables, and syringes will not be accepted due to potential hazard posed by blood-borne pathogens. Marijuana and illicit substances such as methamphetamines are not a part of this initiative and should not be placed in collection containers.
