<b>ARC of Lane County</b> to support parenting education, 2022-23	Springfield	\$72,000	The ARC of Lane County will provide parent support to 300 families raising a child with an intellectual and/or developmental disability in rural Lane County (including the more rural areas of Oakridge, Blue River, Cottage Grove and Florence), also known as the Families Connected/Familias en Conexion program. Funds will be used to strengthen connection and provide parent education and wrap around supports to families living in rural areas. Support and wrap around services will also be offered to the Mam community in Cottage Grove.
<b>Nurturely</b> to support parenting education, 2022-23	Eugene	\$45,000	Nurturely serves the BIPOC community and is led by the BIPOC community of Lane County. The organization provides culturally specific parent education, supports community-building, and provides wellness resources to parents who are pregnant or have a newborn. OCF funds will be used to offer a 5-week bilingual preventative wellness education program for Black and Latinx parents.
<b>Safe Haven Maternity Home</b> to support parenting education, 2022-23	Roseburg	\$6,000	Safe Haven Maternity Home provides a home environment of safety and support to women in crisis who are pregnant or with an infant. Safe Haven is a long-term, on-going program in Douglas County that serves eight women and babies at a time. Programming includes a variety of life-skills classes, parenting classes, support and encouragement to all residents. Residents of the program are low-income and rural families. OCF funds will be used to add staff to teach additional educational classes, provide part-time childcare during classes and upgrading computers in the residence program.
