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Clatsop County 2023 Business Personal Property Returns in the Mail

Jan. 6, 2023 (Astoria, OR) — Clatsop County Assessment and Taxation has mailed local businesses personal property returns that must be completed and postmarked, or returned to Clatsop County Assessment and Taxation office, by 5 p.m. Wednesday, March 15, 2023.

Regardless of business size or nonprofit status, all Oregon businesses are required to file a [Confidential Personal Property Return](#). The return must list all taxable personal property that is used or held for use in the business as of Sunday, Jan. 1, 2023.

If the completed form is returned after the March 15 deadline, a penalty fee will be assessed:

- If received on or before June 1, a late penalty of 5 percent of the tax owed will be assessed.
- If received after June 1, 2023, the penalty fee increases to 25 percent
- If received after August 1, 2023, the penalty increases to 50 percent.
- If a return is not received, a late penalty will be assessed and an estimated value of the equipment will be assigned.
