Thank you for your service to keeping our communities safe.

I am encouraging you to directly contact my office when someone who has received a commutation and is on supervision violates the conditions of release in a manner that warrants revocation of their commutation. Supporting information and a revocation recommendation should be directed to Nicole Townsend, Director of Extradition Services / IAD Administrator / Executive Clemency Coordinator at [nicole.townsend@oregon.gov](mailto:nicole.townsend@oregon.gov).

I review each revocation request individually, based on the facts of each case and with an aim of keeping our communities safe. If I believe someone is violating their conditions of release or supervision and revocation is warranted, I will not hesitate to use my authority and discretion as Governor to revoke their commutation.

Again, I am grateful for the hard work that you and your employees engage in everyday to ensure that our communities are kept safe. I look forward to further collaboration with you.
