WHEREAS: Each year, Oregon's underground utility infrastructure is jeopardized by preventable damage

by those who fail to contact Oregon 811 to have underground utilities located prior to

digging; and

WHEREAS: The Oregon Utility Notification Center provides a free service that notifies utility companies

of the intent to dig by calling 811 or submitting a request online; and

WHEREAS: After notification is made, professional utility locators provide color coded paint markings on

the ground to indicate the presence of underground utilities; and

WHEREAS: Failure to locate underground utilities before digging may result in undesired consequences

such as critical service interruption, damage to the environment, property damage, personal

injury, and even death; and

WHEREAS: Through awareness of safe digging practices, professional excavators and homeowners can

save time and money keeping our state safe and connected by calling or clicking in advance of any digging project, waiting the required time for lines to be located, and digging with

care around the marked lines; and

WHEREAS: Safe digging is a shared responsibility, and the damage prevention community reminds all

excavators that "Safety is in your hands. Every Dig. Every Time."

THEREFORE: I, Tina Kotek, Governor of the State of Oregon, hereby proclaim April 2024 to be

NATIONAL SAFE DIGGING MONTH

in Oregon and encourage all Oregonians to join in this observance.
